### WHITEHERN HISTORIC HOUSE & GARDEN

(HISTORY > HERITAGE HOMES/ESTATES)

Prominently situated in a walled garden, Whitehern is an outstanding example of a mid-nineteenth-century urban estate originally owned by a wealthy industrialist. The house has a multi-layered character that reflects the alterations made by three generations of McQuestens. It contains elements from many time periods—Georgian, Victorian and Edwardian—all overlaid with original possessions dating up to 1939. Explore the heritage of Victorian ideas and possessions that influenced life at Whitehern on the eve of W.W. II when the niceties of a bygone era were about to disappear forever.
